Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to Kennett High School! We are excited to have your child join us for the 2023-'24 school year. In an effort to make this transition as smooth as possible, we will be hosting all incoming 9th graders for a **Freshman Transition Day** at KHS on **Tuesday, August 29, 2023 from 9:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.**, with drop-off beginning at 8:30 a.m.

Grade 9 is shaped by having a group of teachers work with our students to make their school experience personalized and meaningful. A key component of our 9th grade is making sure that it is a smooth transition into Kennett High School from the local sending schools. This involves making connections, building community, and developing a strong academic foundation for your child.

To aid in the transition from middle school to high school, students attend classes in a central location on the second floor for their English, Science, Math, and Social Studies courses, keeping them in close proximity to their 9th grade peers and teachers. Students are supported by their team of core academic teachers, but also have the support of our student services, including school counseling, special services, and other necessary support to help them thrive and succeed. In addition to the core academic areas, the 9th grade experience also focuses on skills that help your child throughout their school career and beyond, into their adult lives.

By the end of their 9th grade year, your child will grow in their understanding of the following:

- The importance and need for empathy, kindness, and respectful interaction with all members of the school community.
- How to appropriately use available resources to manage academic and social challenges.
- Preparation, time management, self-advocacy, and developing effective inquiry skills that will lead to improved academic success.
- Active learning occurs through collaborating, taking risks, and overcoming setbacks.

To prepare your child for the upcoming school year the following list of supplies is recommended by the 9th Grade House teachers:

- A way to organize your papers for each class (folders for each class or a single 3-ring binder)
- Pens and pencils
- Composition Notebook (for Math)
- Single subject notebook/composition notebook (for English)

This day will end with lunch and a raffle.

Students will also have the opportunity to ease into some of the most common, yet anxiety-provoking routines without the added pressure of upperclassmen being present and the rush of the bell schedule.
